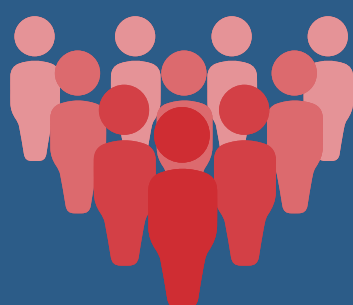


GLOBAL BIOSAFETY IS COMPLEX

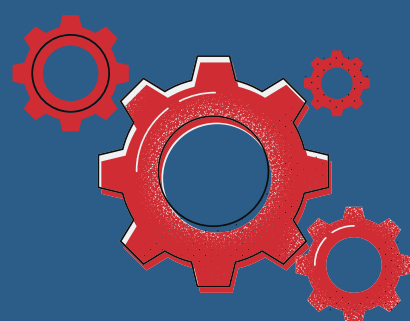


IFBA'S ROLE
