TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK



THREE DAY SAFARI TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK

Tarangire National Park lies about 120km southwest of Arusha City and is well known for its huge population of elephants per square kilometer, more than any other national park in the country. In addition to elephants, you can expect to see huge game of other animals such as lions, giraffes, wildebeest, zebras, huge herds of buffalos and many others.

Tarangire National Park is well known for its abundance of ancient baobab trees which makes the landscape so beautiful.

Day 1: Arusha to Tarangire

Our safari guide will pick you up at your hotel 7am and start a beautiful journey to Tarangire National Park. Along the way, you will cross the Maasai Steppe land which is an important landscape in Northeastern Tanzania covering approximately 40,000 km. It includes Tarangire and Lake Manyara National Parks. In Tarangire you will have amazing opportunities to view wild animals in their natural habitat. You will take time to explore the Tarangire River's twists and turns, where you will find various animals drinking water and playing in the catchment areas. In the afternoon, a picnic lunch will be served overlooking amazing views of the Tarangire River.

Dinner and overnight: <u>Tarangire Safari Lodge</u>

Day 2: Tarangire Full Day

A light breakfast will be available at the lodge before our safari guide picks you up 6:30am to start your day with another sunrise game drive focusing on areas of the park you haven't explored yet. Expect to have a picnic lunch in the park.

Day 3: Tarangire to Arusha

After your morning breakfast you will have a short game drive making your way out of the park and head straight to Arusha.

After your morning breakfast, you will proceed to the endless plains of the Serengeti National Park. As we start entering this beautiful park you will be amazed with **Kopjes** which are distinctive feature of the Serengeti landscape. They offer a hiding place for animals and a vantage point for predators. Also we will be looking for other animals like elephants and hippos on our way to the camp. Check into Nyikani Camp and have lunch. Continue exploring the Serengeti with an afternoon game drive.

Dinner and overnight: Nyikani Serengeti Camp


Day 5: Serengeti

Enjoy a picnic lunch in the bush.
